

Win Classics Terms and Conditions

The Promoter

1. The promoter is named as Win Classics Ltd, Company Number 14534990, with a registered office at 18, Farfield Avenue, Hepworth, Holmfirth, HD9 1TT
2. All contact should be by email to info@winclassics.co.uk. Contact by any other method will not be replied to.
3. These terms and conditions apply to all competitions listed by Win Classics Ltd on their competition website www.winclassics.co.uk

The competition

1. Competitions can only be entered via our website, www.winclassics.co.uk
2. All competitions will have a knowledge based element and an entry fee is payable each time you enter. Where Win Classics Ltd offers a multiple choice question, a free entry route is also available.
3. To be in with a chance of winning, everyone who enters the competition will be required to correctly answer a question set by Win Classics Ltd.
4. Competitions are governed by English Law and any matters relating to the Competition will be resolved under English Law and the Courts of England shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
5. There will be a maximum number of entries per competition, this will be shown on the competition page for the individual prize.
6. The competition will run from and including the opening and closing dates specified on the Website. All times and dates referred to on the website are the times and dates in London, England.
7. The Win Classics Ltd reserves the right to change the Opening and Closing Dates of any competition without prior warning to participants.
8. If the Promoter does change the Opening Date and/or the Closing Date of a competition, the new details will be displayed on the competition Website as soon as is reasonably possible.

1. Charity donation

1. To other people who supply us with a service, e.g. delivery companies, website hosts, payment providers, businesses which help us send communications or monitor our website and which provide us with e-commerce, analytics and other IT services.
2. To law enforcement authorities to help deal with fraud and abuse and/or comply with legal requirements.
3. To insurers and professional advisers in connection with our insurance cover or to deal with legal claims.
4. To potential buyers so far as reasonably necessary, in the case of an actual or proposed (including negotiations for a) sale or merger or business combination involving all or the relevant part of our business.

Do we send your information outside the European Union?

What about cookies?

1. Win Classics Ltd use cookies and other tracking technologies on our website. A cookie is an identifier (a small file of letters and numbers) that is sent to your web browser.
